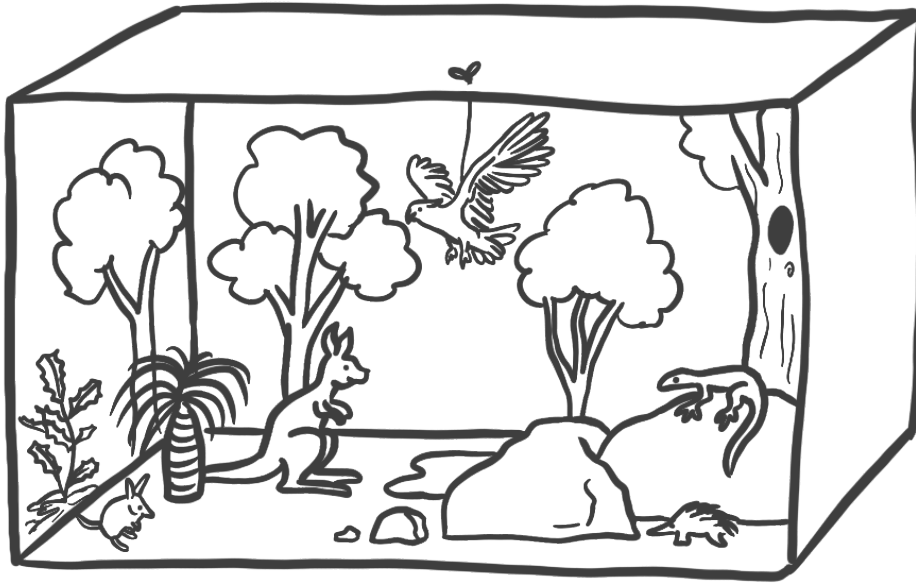


ENVIRO-DIORAMA



MATERIALS NEEDED

- A large shoe box
- Sheets of plain paper or cardboard
- Glue
- Scissors
- Drawing and colouring materials
- String
- Whatever else you'd like to make your scene more interesting – twigs, pebbles, leaves, flowers, etc.

WHAT IS A DIORAMA?

A diorama is a mini-world – a scene in a box. It's a fun project for students to show what they know about their local environment.

STEP 1

First you need to give your diorama a background. Measure the walls, ceilings and floors of your box and then cut your sheets of paper/cardboard according to these measurements. Create your background on the paper/cardboard: you could draw blue skies, a leafy forest, a deep blue sea... anything you like!

STEP 2

Glue your background onto the walls, ceilings and floors of your diorama.

STEP 3

Now it's time to create your scene. Use whatever you have to create miniature animals, plants, rocks and so on. Glue them to the ground and even hang birds from the ceiling to make your diorama more exciting!
